3.3 2016 SCAG Regional Screenline Count Study

CS is currently undertaking a comprehensive traffic data collection and data assimilation project for SCAG. Traffic counts are being conducted at over 500 arterial locations and 30 freeway locations. In addition, data from the Caltrans Performance Measurement System (PeMS), UC Irvine's Truck Activity Monitoring System (TAMS), and a variety of other local sources are also being obtained. All of these data will be housed in a database that will be used by SCAG staff to support model validation. CS will present an overview of the project, describe the work done-to-date, and identify upcoming steps and milestones.
